High Tech in Jerusalem

This special program, which will prepare new immigrant students for higher education in high tech and sciences, will operate as part of a national project to develop the high tech industry in Jerusalem. The program will take place at the Hadassah Academic College under the supervision of the Student Authority. Emphasis will be placed on mathematics, computers, Hebrew, English, and preparation for the psychometric exam.

Upon graduation from the program, students will be able to continue their studies either at the college or at other academic institutions in Jerusalem.

In addition to academic studies, lectures by representatives of the high tech Industry will be held, as well as visits to the industry and participation in social activities and tours of Jerusalem.

Who is the program meant for?

Students who have completed one academic year abroad in these subjects

High school graduates with high scholastic achievements in mathematics and physics, who intend to study at institutions which do not require an academic preparatory program

Students with a Bachelor's degree in sciences or technology who wish to continue on to receive a Master's degree

Conditions of Acceptance

Eligibility for Student Authority assistance

High grades in Mathematics

Knowledge of the Hebrew language (completion of at least one ulpan). Applicants will take the entrance exams in Hebrew & Mathematics in December

The English exam will take place at the beginning of the program.

Dates and Duration

Opening twice a year: January\February + July\August

Duration of the program is 5 months

The first ulpan can be taken at Ulpan Ezion in Jerusalem or any other ulpan

Accomodation

During the program, (including the Hebrew ulpan at Ezion), students will be housed at the Jewish Agency dorms in Mercaz Klita Bezek, Ramat Beit Hakerem in Jerusalem. (450 shekels per month*)

Assistance provided by the Student Authority

The program is funded by the Students Authority, and is **NOT** included in the 3 years entitlement for tuition fees
