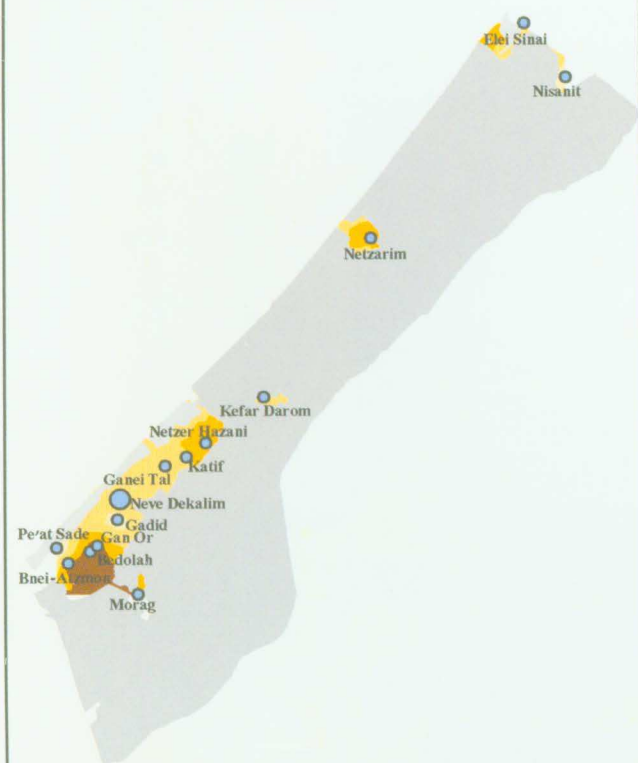

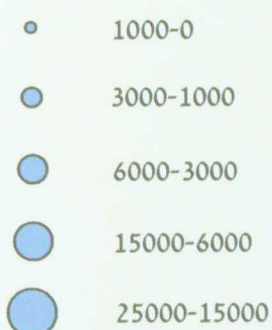

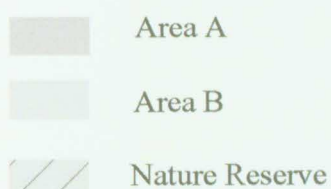

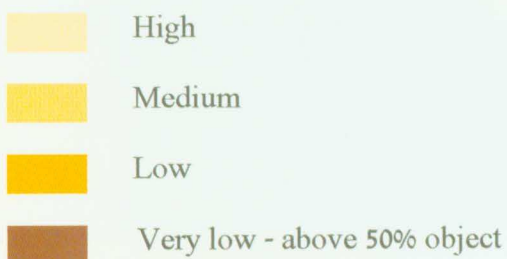

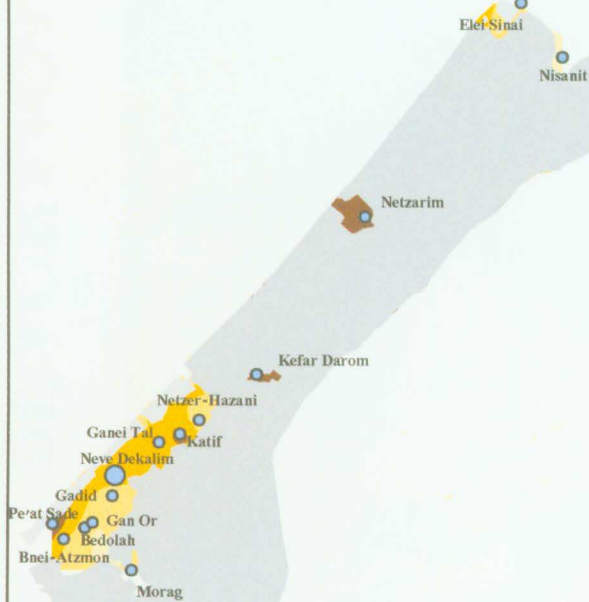

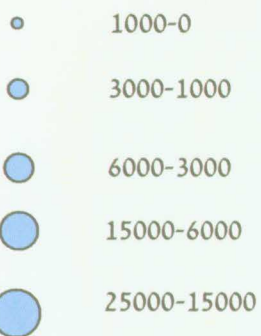

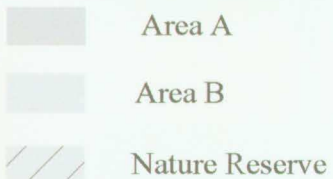

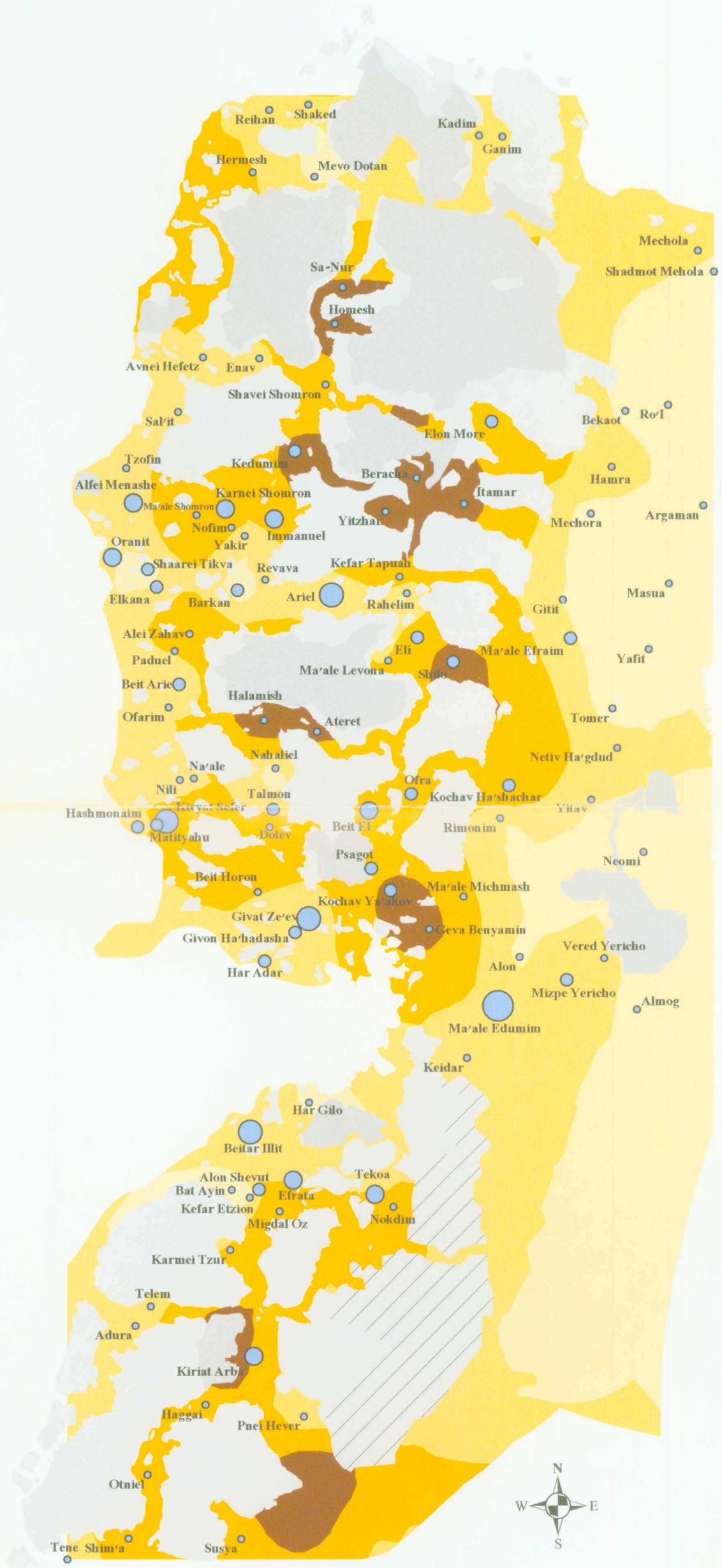

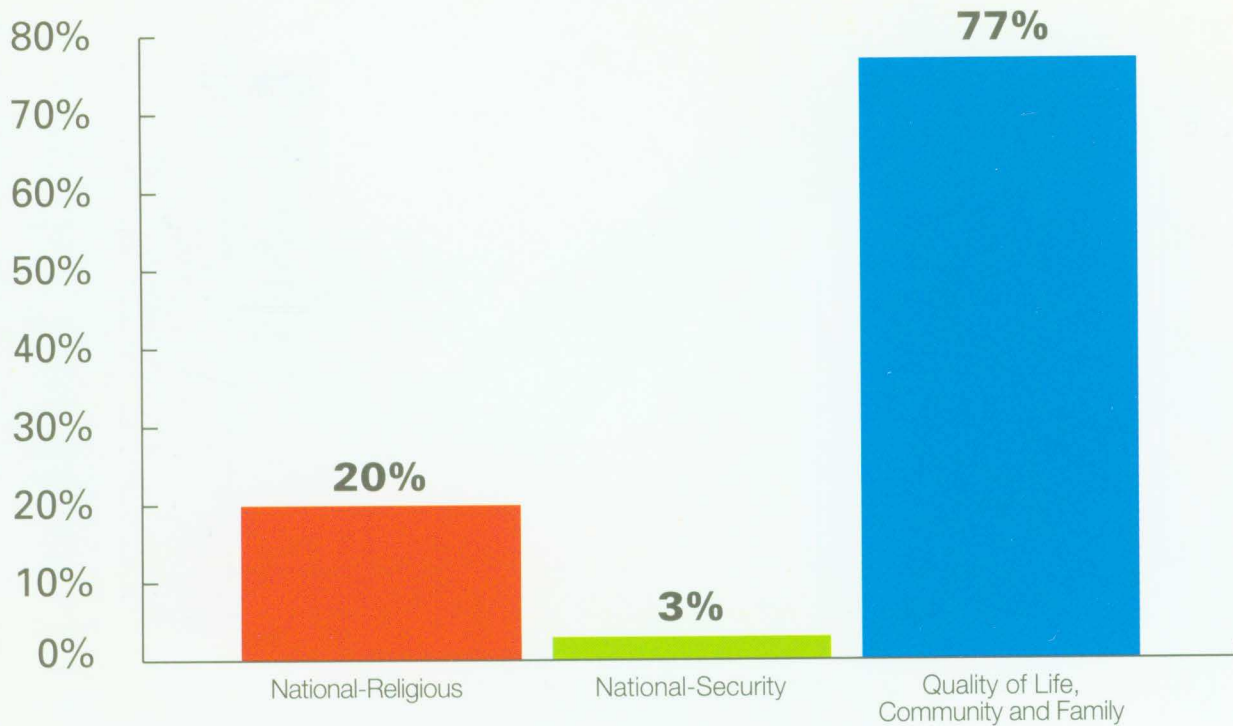

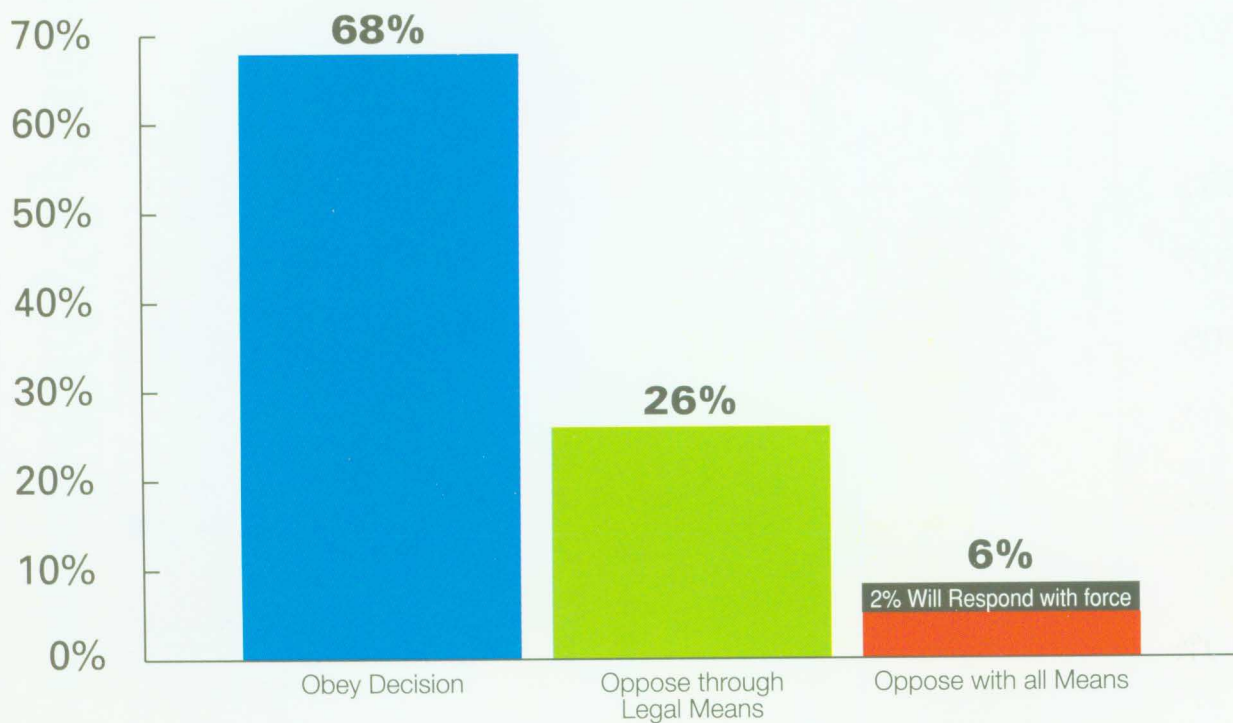

Main Reason for Living in Settlement

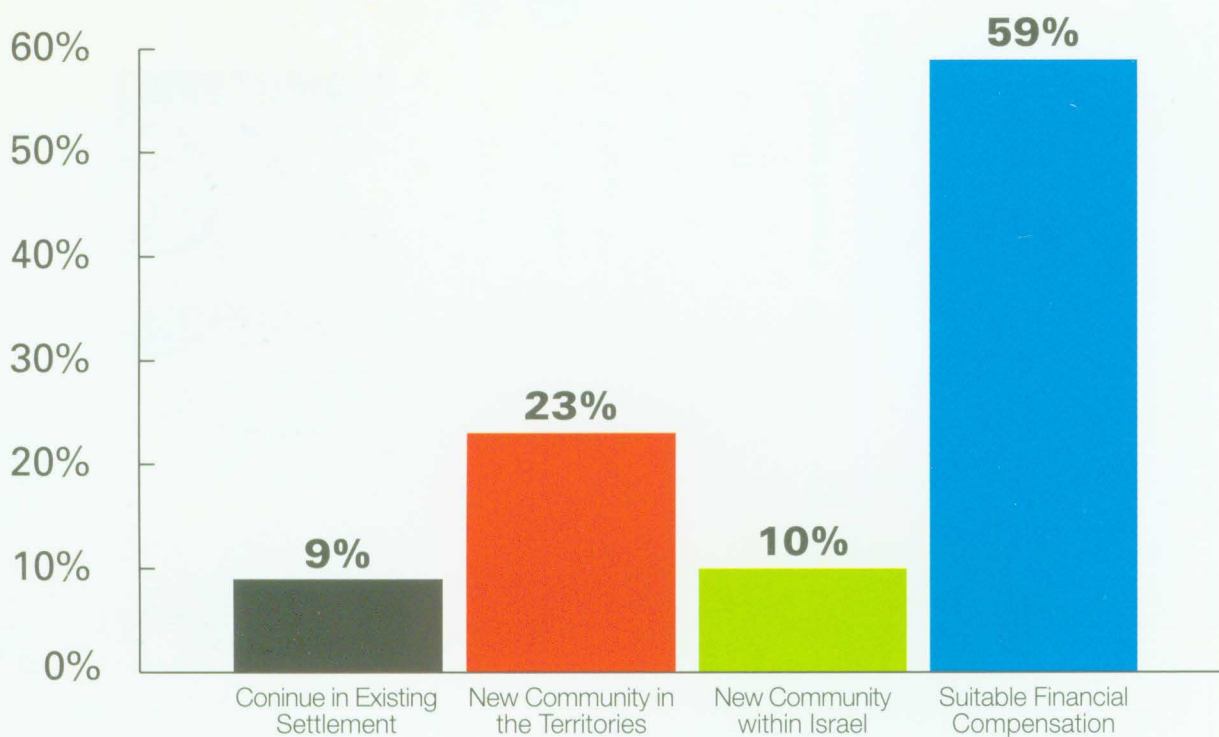


Expected Response to Withdrawal Decision

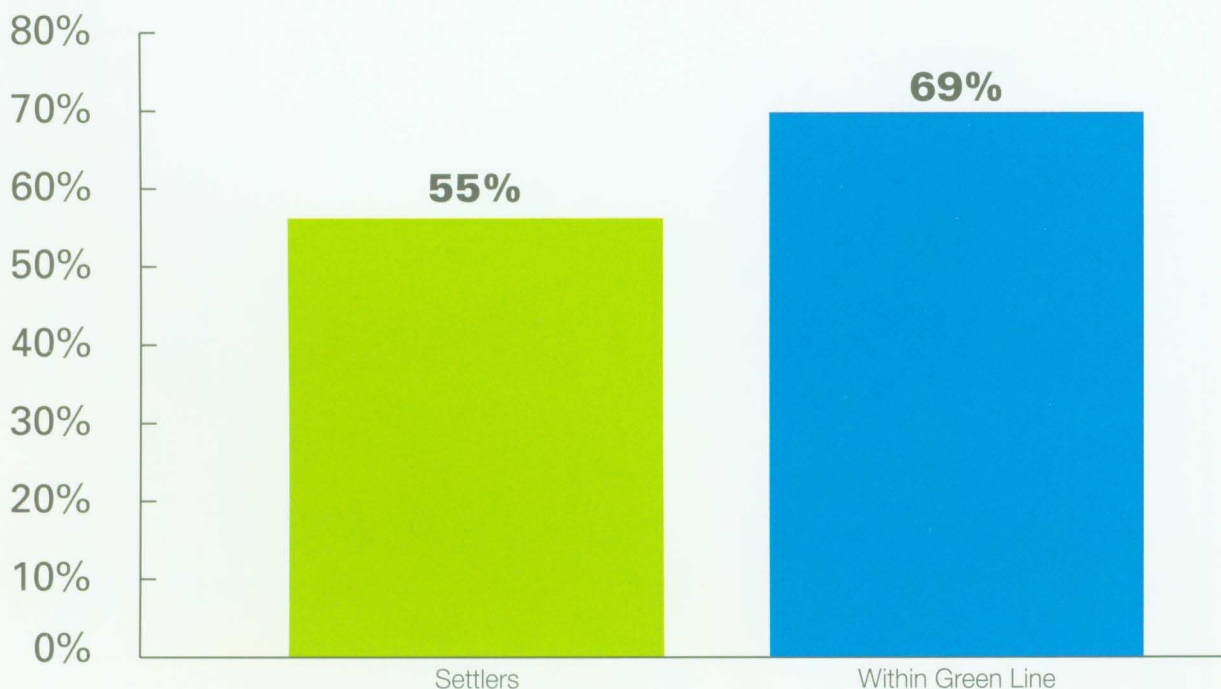


In this graph the extreme group is divided into two sub-groups. Only 2% will respond with force.
