H. & W.P.

H.&W.P is a unique program which offers the opportunity to learn Hebrew while living and working within the communal kibbutz environment.

The purpose of this program is to provide the participant with the possibility of having some personal experience of kibbutz life and at the same time to provide a fair knowledge of conversational Hebrew, the ability to read simple texts and the basis for further study of the language.

The duration of the H&WP program is three months .

You are eligible to join this program if you are aged 19-30, single or married without children, in good physical and mental health, capable of physical work, willing to abide by the norms and rules of the place and pay your registration fee.

Hebrew lessons

You will study 12 hours a week, which will be divided over the week into several lessons. Each class will consist of 15-25 students. Your teachers are specially trained to teach Hebrew as a foreign language for adults.

Work on kibbuts

Participants will work 35 hours per week which will be spread over the week, in coordination with your studies. As a rule, you should be prepared to do any kind of work you are requested to. Thus, you may be assigned to the fields (orchards, gardens, etc.), dairy, factories, kitchen, dining hall, etc.

Please note that kibbutz members tend to evaluate people by their attitude to work. In any case, remember that your work goes toward paying your upkeep on the kibbutz (including your Hebrew lessons).

Housing and other details

There will be dormitories with two or three participants to a room with adjacent toilet and shower facilities. You will receive full board as well as sheets, blankets, pillows, towels, work clothes and shoes, laundry services, toilet supplies and a small monthly allowance which will include pocket money and/or coupons for use in the "store" of the kibbutz.

Free time

Saturday (the Sabbath) is your weekly rest day. Occasionally, you may be requested to work on Saturday (someone must do the job!). In that case, you will receive your rest day during the week. You are also entitled to one extra day off each month. The kibbutz will organize excursions (up to three days) during your three months stay there.

Except for certain activities of strictly internal nature, you are invited to participate in the social and cultural events that take place on the kibbutz for its members. Of course, sport facilities, swiraming pool, library etc., are open for you. Enjoy them!.

You will be entitled to routine and emergency medical care. However, in addition to this coverage you must obtain your own personal medical insurance (including hospitalization) according to your own terms. We also advise you to insure all valuables. While this is the individual's responsibility, we can assist you in purchasing a suitable insurance policy.

Responsibilities

The kibbutz will do its utmost to help you when necessary, but it will not be responsible for your welfare when you leave the premises of the kibbutz on your own, or act contrary to the standing safety order of the kibbutz concerning the swimming pool, trips, beach etc.

The kibbutz will not be responsible for your valuables, and/or money which are not deposited at the kibbutz secretariat.

The kibbutz will not be responsible for your travel arrangements.

Since it changes from time to time - the information will be given to you at the time of your registration.

In order to apply in Israel you must arrange an interview in advance. Please bring with you: - passport + valid visa

- a letter of recommendation
- US\$220 - registration fee -
- health insurance policy

You will be able to purchase the relevant text book at the kibbutz.
